The Idaho Governor's Cup Scholarship

The Idaho Governor's Cup Scholarship is available to high school seniors and home school students throughout Idaho. All proceeds from the Idaho Governor's Cup are dedicated to funding this program. Academic and career-technical awards are offered to those students who plan to further their education at an Idaho college or university and who demonstrate a strong commitment to public service.

Academic scholarship recipients receive \$5,000 each year, renewable up to four years, while scholarship recipients pursuing a career technical education or trade school education receive \$3,000 per year for the length of the program, up to three years. By participating in this year's event, you provide more opportunities for Idaho students to further their education in our great state.

Step-by-Step Registration Guide

Registration for the Idaho Governor's Cup is online. Follow the steps below to register. Registration must be received by August 4th to ensure clothing size availability.

Sponsored Guests – Deadline is August 4th

1. Go to the Idaho Governor's Cup website at www.idahogovernorscup.org.
2. Click the "Register Now" button.
3. You will be taken to our event registration page on Eventbrite.
4. As a sponsored guest, first enter your promotional code by clicking on the link above the green "order now" button that says "enter promotional code" and click apply. This will make sure you do not pay for your registration. If you do not know your promotional code, please contact either your sponsor or the Idaho Governor's Cup for assistance.
5. Enter the number of guests you will be registering next to the event in which you will participate (Golf, Shotgun, etc.).
6. Click the green "Register" button.
7. Enter all the information for yourself or the person you are registering.
NOTE: You will not be able to proceed unless you fill in all the required fields.
8. Click the green "Complete Registration" button.
9. You will receive a confirmation email from Eventbrite. The email will include information on what to expect when you arrive in Sun Valley as well as a list of events for which you are registered.

Men and women have the opportunity to play golf together on two spectacular courses managed by Sun Valley, the Trail Creek Golf Course and Elkhorn Golf Course. Golfers will have the opportunity to play in either team scramble format or team best ball and individual stroke play format.

The team scramble format will have two flights, gross and net. Winners will be determined by a two-day (Friday and Saturday) team total.

The team best ball format will have one flight, gross and net. Winners will be determined by a two-day (Friday and Saturday) team total. Additionally, those playing the team best ball format will be eligible for the individual stroke play tournament. Winners will be named in both gross and net contests. There will also be day prizes at each course for men and women long drive and men and women closest to the pin.

If you have an established handicap, please enter it in the box titled "known handicap" when you register online. Handicaps will be verified prior to the tournament. If you do not have a handicap, please enter your estimated usual average score for 18 holes in the box titled "usual score". A golf professional will assign a handicap for each player who enters a usual score. To manage the net component of the tournament, we need to calculate a team handicap for each team playing in the net format.

The tournament rounds begin on Friday morning and continue through Saturday and will be played on both the Trail Creek Golf Course and Elkhorn Golf Course. Pairings and course assignments will be available at registration. We do not accommodate requests to play a certain course on a certain day. If you are playing both days in the tournament, you will have the opportunity to play both courses. Breakfast is offered at both courses Friday and Saturday morning and a box lunch will be provided both days.

You may schedule a practice round at your own cost on Thursday, September 4, 2025, at the Trail Creek Golf Course for \$185 per round, and at the Elkhorn Golf Course for \$185 per round.

Shotgun Sports

Whether you are new to the sport or an experienced shooter, everybody has fun. The shooting program will be conducted over two days of competitive shooting at the Sun Valley Gun Club and the Hurtig Shooting Center, concluding on Saturday. Participants will shoot up to 200 total targets for score. Prizes will be awarded for each shooting event, 1st and 2nd highest scores in each category and high team score. There will be three categories of shooting participants with programs commensurate with shooting experience.

New/Beginner Shooters - Includes orientation on shotgun safety and learning clay target shooting from an instructor. A separate shooting field will be set up for Beginner Shooters and shotguns will be provided.

- » **Friday:** Shoot targets with instruction.
- » **Saturday:** Finish with a 50-target event on a trap field.

Occasional Shooters - Includes persons who have experience shooting a shotgun or some experience shooting clay targets.

- » **Friday:** Pre-shooting refresher followed by shooting 25 trap targets for score. Shooters will be divided into two groups, Advanced and Novice, based on their score. Following dividing into two groups, the Advanced and Novice shooting programs begin.
- » **Saturday:** Advanced and Novice shooting programs continue, and competition concludes.

Serious Shooters - Includes persons who shoot clay targets competitively or have extensive experience shooting. This is a high-level shooting event. Compete individually and for a five-person team trophy, and a high overall and high woman recognition trophy. These teams have included a Legislator when possible.

- » **Friday:** Pre-shooting refresher and serious shooter program begins with shooting super sporting clays at the Sun Valley Gun Club.
- » **Saturday:** Competition concludes with shooting sporting clays at the Hurtig Shooting Center, located South of Ketchum. High score and team awards will be presented at the awards reception Saturday evening at the Sun Valley Inn.

Important Event Information

Participants are encouraged to bring their own 12- and 20-gauge shotguns. Please indicate on your registration form if you will need a loaner shotgun. Ammunition will be provided for the daily shooting events. Coffee, soft drinks and lunch will be provided to participants each day at the Sun Valley Gun Club.

Fly Fishing



This is an exciting, two-day program with a local fishing guide. If you do not have an Idaho fishing license, it will be taken care of for you through the guide shop. You will receive personal instruction, gear, flies and a boxed lunch. These guided trips take place on several area streams including Silver Creek and the Big Wood River. Anglers of all experience levels enjoy this event. For beginners it is an excellent way to learn the art of fly fishing. For the intermediate and expert angler it is an opportunity to improve your skills in a beautiful part of Idaho.

Gratuities: Your guide is a paid professional. Tips are appropriate and accepted only if he or she exceeded your expectations. Whether you tip and how much you tip should depend on your satisfaction with the trip, your feelings about tipping, and your financial means.

If you believe your guide deserves a tip, a suggested range is between \$75-\$100 per day.

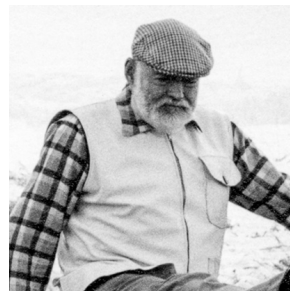
Hemingway Tour
